




A Complex, Interwoven, Knotted Globe




Global leaders requires the 'extreme leadership' to confront the 'extreme complexity' of the 21st century:

- Multiplicity—the increased number and range of issues.
- Interdependence—the complex knot of stakeholders, sociocultural, political, economic, technological, and environmental systems.
- Ambiguity—the lack of clarity caused by multiple interpretations about information, cues, goals, and relationships.
- Flux—the rapid rate of change, transitioning systems, shifting values, and differing emergent structures.

Christians in Global South once again in majority




Christians by continent, 2020




Evangelicals by Continent, 2050







Christians, 2020-2050





An African woman is the face of **Christianity** in the 21st Century!



Largest missionary sending and receiving countries, 2020









Frontier People Groups


- 4,751 groups
