SUPPORT vs PARTNERSHIP

Biblical examples

- Paul/Antioch Acts 13
- Tabernacle Exodus 31
- Temple I Chronicles 22
- Church in Philippi- Philippians 4

QUESTION: Why is it a challenge to be partnership driven?

- Church-driven vision only: where the missionary is the employee
- Missionary-driven vision only: where the church has no involvement or participation in the work





QUESTION: What do churches struggle with the most when it comes to partnership missions?

- Not relationally driven
- Not Kingdom focused

SUPPORT	PARTNERSHIP
Investment into others work	Personal involvement and investment (training/teaching/equipping/expectations) - Ephesians 4/Exodus 31- Tabernacle/David & Solomon- Temple/Nehemiah
Doesn't require much time or effort	Involves planning and personal connection
Not a focused work	Tailored to fit vision
No Benefit/results for church	Benefits both Church and Missionary
Only involves a few people	Greater Church involvement
Easier and traditional model	Long-term sustainability

What drives supporting churches?

- Budget
- Inwardly focused with an undefined missions strategy
- It's an easy and familiar process

What drives partnership churches?

- Relationships
- Vision
- Shared goals
